### 2015/16 Key Stage 1 Assessment Results

In September 2014 the Department for Education (DfE) introduced a new National Curriculum, and the SATs system of levels used to report children's attainment and progress was removed. The new national curriculum does not include levels.

The programmes of study within the new National Curriculum set out expectations at the end of each Key Stage (KS). Schools that follow the National Curriculum are free to develop a curriculum relevant to their pupils that teaches this content.

Each school's curriculum must include an assessment system that allows it "to check what pupils have learned and whether they are on track to meet expectations at the end of the Key Stage and to report regularly to parents".

Each year group now has a list of objectives which are entitled 'age related expectations', and reporting will allow parents to see whether their child is working towards, has met or is exceeding the new age related expectations.

#### The results for 2015/16 are presented in the table below
